



Dolphin Cottage is a refurbished Coastguard Cottage just two minutes from the pier at Sennen Cove. The terrace is set behind the harbour car park (lowest white terrace in the photo).



The outlook from the front is across to the rocks of Cowloe, visible at low tide, and across Whitesands Bay to Cape Cornwall. Because of its position at the far end of the village, close to the lookout point, it is quiet and peaceful

throughout the year. A brisk five minute walk (on the flat) will take you to the famous Old Success Inn and the surf shop and access to the beach, whilst nearer to hand is the village shop, selling excellent pasties amongst other things, the ice cream shop and the Round House gallery. The lifeboat station is open for visits daily in the summer and you can fish from the end of the pier. The coastal path goes past the end of the terrace leading to Lands End and there is climbing at Sennen Crag on the Mayon peninsula (five minutes walk – shown in photo below). The beach speaks for itself with sand and surf. At low tide, there is plenty of room for beach cricket and rock pools to explore.

The cottage is a “two-up, two-down” with a small shower-room. The front door leads from a shared outer lobby into the living room with a wood-burning stove, sofas, television and DVD player – just the spot to curl up when the south-westerlies are blowing!



To the rear is the kitchen/diner, refurbished with oven and hob, fridge (with icebox), dishwasher and washing/drying machine and kitchen table and chairs for 4 people. The back door leads outside.

A latch door in the living room leads upstairs and into the main bedroom. From here, the sound of the sea is a peaceful accompaniment at any time. This room has a double bed. From it a small inner lobby leads to the shower-room, with washbasin, shower and WC; and the second bedroom with two fitted bunkbeds, suitable for older children and most adults. Our children love this room, which is like a den, whilst being light and airy, with its own wardrobe.



At the back of the property is a common passageway to all the cottages. There is space to hang wetsuits etc to dry out here and a set of shared rough steps up the steep bank to a small terrace shared with the neighbouring Gull Cottage.



It is possible to drive right up to the front door, but only to drop off and unload – this is a right of way to other properties. There is no parking immediately outside the house but there is often space about 100 yards away on a track beyond the main car park. Failing that, the Harbour car park is available (pay & display).
